



Koi Show Rules and Regulations

ENTRY

This is an English style show open to koi hobbyists. All fish shown must be the personal and private property of the registrant. This is a hobbyist show and therefore is not open to persons deriving significant income as a koi dealer or from selling imported fish. **The fish owner must attend the show and sign the koi entry form.**

1. Fish registration is open from noon-4:30 PM, Friday November 5th or prior arrangement, from 7:30-8:30 am Saturday, November 6th. Call Sherri White for arrangements at 386-767-0814
2. **FEE: PRE-REGISTRATION IS MANDATORY.** The reservation and fee should be postmarked no later than October 23, 2010. Early registration is encouraged to insure availability of a tank. Call Sherri at 386-767-0814 for any special needs.
3. Photos will be taken at registration and are included in the tank fee.

DELIVERY & REMOVAL OF FISH

1. For the protection and health of your koi, feeding should be discontinued for a minimum of 5 days prior to the show.
2. Entrants must remain at registration area until all paperwork is done for registration and their fish have been benched and released into their appropriate tanks.
3. Entrants must supply their own Show Bowl (**plastic tub**) and **net** to bowl their fish. Bowl must be large enough to properly house/display the Koi (except for Koi over 22 inches). **Note:** Koi over 22 inches will not require bowls.
4. The KOI ENTRY FORM must be completely filled out, signed and full payment of entry fees made prior to fish being accepted into the show. The benching committee will measure and classify each fish.
5. Fish will be on display for the duration of the show.
6. Koi may be removed from the show site after notifying a fish attendant. Only Koi entered in the show are to be in show tanks during judging.
7. Owners will be asked to attest that koi entered in this show are not KHV survivors, have not been in contact with any fish known to have KHV or be a survivor of KHV or injected with KHV vaccine.

JUDGING

1. Judging will begin at 10:30am on Saturday, November 6th.
2. Prior to judging, all fish will be reviewed by the Show Committee for disease and significant injury and to assure the fish are entered in the proper size and class. No one other than the judges, Show Committee, fish handlers, or water quality personnel will be allowed inside the inner show tank area.
3. Judging will be open to silent viewing with no comments or questions from the audience.
4. Awards will be given at the banquet on Saturday night.
5. Move Ups will fill slots of fish moved to Grand Champion, Grand Champion B, Reserve Grand Champion, Mature Champion, Young Champion, Baby Champion, Best in Size and Best in Variety.
6. NO ONE is allowed to handle any fish except the judges and fish handlers. Anyone wishing to inspect his or her personal fish must first contact the Koi Show Director.
7. GIN RIN: Koi with Kin Gin Rin scales will be placed in the Kinginrin variety. All Doitsu will be in respective variety.
8. The decisions of the Show Committee are FINAL. They will decide any contingencies not covered by these rules.

AWARDS

Awards will be presented Saturday evening, November 6th at the Gardens. The judges will share their observations regarding the positive attributes of the koi and comment about the features of the winning fish. **NOTE:** See Sherri White by early Saturday afternoon if your club would like to give a Friendship Award. .
