

# ZNA JUDGE PROGRAM

ZNA judge program is established for skilled koi hobbyists to attend koi show judging.

The following is the brief criteria for ZNA chapter members to apply for ZNA judges. However, as each chapter or district has its own training judge program prior to the ZNA headquarters program, ask your chapter first thing if you are interested in judging.

Conditions and Procedures to ZNA judges

## **ENTER ZNA CHAPTER**

<conditions for Local Certified Judge>

- (1) Non koi dealer or non business breeder
- (2) 5-year ZNA chapter membership
- (3) 5 ZNA show judging experiences (ZNA shows only)
- (4) 2 ZNA koi seminar attendances can be switched from two of the above koi show judging experiences.

<making an application>

- (5) Submit an application form with a chapter president recommendation letter and signature to the ZNA head office
- (6) Written application is examined every late January



## **LOCAL CERTIFIED JUDGE**

<registration>

- (7) Local Certified Judge registration fee 20,000 JPY for first three years
- (8) 10,000 JPY renewal registration fee every three years



<conditions for Assistant Certified Judge>

- (1) 2-more-year ZNA chapter membership since Local Certified Judge registration
- (2) 5 more ZNA show judging experiences as Local Certified Judge (ZNA shows only)
- (3) 3 more ZNA koi seminar attendances can be

switched from three of the above show judges  
<making an application>

- (4) Submit an application form with a chapter president recommendation letter and signature to the head office to take an Assistant Certified Judge examination held late January.

<examination>

- (5) Take an Assistant Certified Judge examination (practical koi ranking and written comment)
- (6) Examination fee 15,000JPY



## **ASSISTANT CERTIFIED JUDGE**

<registration>

- (7) Assistant Certified Judge registration fee 30,000 JPY for first three years
- (8) 20,000 JPY renewal registration fee every three years



<conditions for Certified Judge>

- (1) 2-more-year ZNA chapter membership since <Assistant Certified Judge registration>
- (2) 2 Japan District show judging experiences as Assistant Certified Judge
- (3) 5 ZNA Japan koi seminar attendances (held in Japan every September and January)

<making an application>

- (4) Submit koi keeping experience report, chapter activity history and an application form with a chapter president recommendation letter and signature to the head office.
- (5) Written application is examined every May



## **CERTIFIED JUDGE**

- (6) Certified Judge registration fee 60,000 JPY for first three years
- (7) 40,000 JPY renewal registration fee every three years

\*District chairman's recommendation letter and signature is required in the US District and the Taiwan District.
